

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL)

THE ASSESSMENT OF CURRENT COMPETENCE

Kwindla Institute of Learning & Consulting has procedures for assessing and recognising prior learning. This includes procedures for the selection of potential RPL candidates to support them through the **RPL process**.

The RPL process involves the following:- identification, documentation, assessment, evaluation and transcription of prior learning against specified learning outcomes. So that such learning can articulate with admissions requirements to target programmes and be recognised for entry, exemption or accreditation purposes.

The assessment instruments developed for RPL are designed and implemented in accordance with our policies on fair and transparent assessment.

An analysis will only be done on relevant industry-related qualifications obtained within the past two years.

An analysis will be done on credits obtained towards approved Further Education qualifications at NQF Level 4 & 5.

Mapping will be done to determine if the correct “Core”, “Fundamental” and “Elective” unit standards were obtained to adhere to the qualification requirements.

A learner specific learning programme will be compiled to address the unit standards required for the full qualification.

Requirements to do the analysis

- Matric certificate or equivalent to matric,
- Previous qualification/skills programmes/unit standards or non-credit bearing programs.
- Name of the qualification you wish to register with us.
